

Farm Tractor Pull Rules

1. No turbos below 9000, 9500 turbo and up require a wide front.
2. Tractors must have all wheels and attached rear fenders.
3. Contest is open to all rubber-tired, farmer-owned tractors. (No industrial)
4. Tractors may enter in more than one class, with entry fee for each class, but only once in each class
5. Weight includes driver. No weight changes. All weights must be securely fastened to the tractor chassis. Front weights must not extend beyond 24 inches of the tractor. Loss of weight will disqualify entry.
6. Stationary hook point height is a maximum of 20 inches from the ground to the top of hitch point with hitches no closer than 18 inches to center of the rear axle. No drawbar will be allowed to be raised after the pull has started.
7. Bring own 3" clevis. Pulling eyes will be permitted. Must be bolted with a 1 inch bolt or drawbar pin. Sled hook must hook in and out freely.
8. No dual wheels, tire chains or sharpened tires are not permitted.
9. Maximum speed will be determined by the judges and announced at drivers meeting, Factory RPM. Pace tractor or horn will be used on stock farm classes.
10. Each tractor pull will end when the tractor spins out, powers out, stops or is stopped by judges. Anyone who fails to stop when judge red flags them will be disqualified.
11. Drivers must be 18 years of age or older. Unless approved by the head judge.
12. Contestants will have one chance to change gears within the first 100ft.
13. The tractor driver must remain seated at all times during the pull and must have one hand on the steering wheel.
14. Tractors/Pickups may be checked after their pull if there is any question or rule violation.
15. Any persons under the influence of alcohol or operating a tractor in an unsafe manner will be disqualified.
16. All tractors must have factory starters and PTOs.
17. All engines must appear visibly stock
18. Straight exhaust on turbo tractors.
19. Only one turbo for stock farm classes.
20. Pickups must be registered, insured and street legal. No weights or blocks
25" hitch height.*
21. All decisions of the Rules Committee are final
